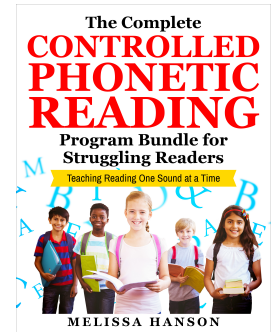


Controlled Phonetic Reading
